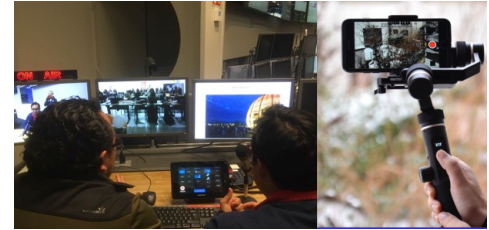


# Outreach and educational activities of the ALICE collaboration during the COVID pandemic

The multitude of online platforms available helped ensure the continuity of outreach and educational activities (visits, masterclasses) of ALICE in the times of the pandemic.

**Virtual visits** : Done via zoom / webinar; videoconferencing equipment in the control room, mobile equipment for the underground tour.

Remote audiences get a glimpse of a CERN experiment and interact with scientists; often virtual visitors see much more than during a visit in-person.



Sept. 2020 – Aug. 2021: ~ 70 virtual visits in 10 languages, >25 countries; reached some thousands

**Online masterclasses** : Done with web-based versions of the masterclasses packages, needing no installation of software; zoom for the talks/zoom breakout rooms for the data analysis.

They allow participation of students who normally could not travel to institutes. More freedom in organisation (no pc rooms needed, lecturers, tutors, moderators connect from anywhere).
