The European Strategy for Particle Physics

- The European Strategy for Particle Physics is updated typically every 5 years (see [last update in 2020](#), [Strategy](#) and [Physics Briefing Book](#))
- It is prepared by the European Strategy Group (ESG) based on the scientific input from the community summarised by the Physics Preparatory Group (PPG) in a Briefing Group.
- **March CERN Council:**
 - Decided to anticipate the next update by one year to allow for a timely decision on the CERN future programme and to maintain Europe's world leadership and offer a bright future for young generations.
 - The overall timeline of the Strategy update was approved.
 - **31 March 2025:** deadline for the submission of community input
 - **June 2025:** Open Symposium
 - **December 2025:** Drafting session
 - **March and June 2026:** Council discussion and approval of Strategy
- **June CERN Council:** Council elected Karl Jakobs (University of Freiburg) as Strategy Secretary and established both the Strategy Secretariat and the European Strategy Group.

Input from the Spanish CPAN community plan

- **7 October 2024:** National workshop on FCC (CIEMAT, Madrid) to define the position of Spain towards this project.
- **5 November 2024:** Deadline to send comments to the Editorial Board (via: nicanor.colino@ciemat.es, Maria.Jose.Costa@ific.uv.es, m.pilar.hernandez@uv.es, celso.martinez@csic.es, carlos.salgado@usc.es)
 - The IPs of the various networks have been contacted to lead the discussions within their communities and provide a collective input.
 - Input can also be provided at the group or even individual level.
- **19-21 November 2024:** CPAN days:
 - 19 November morning: Future Colliders for Early Career Researchers plenary session (open to the whole community)
 - 19 November - 20 November parallel sessions: Presentation and discussion on the input of the networks at the different parallel sessions
 - 21 November – Report from the Editorial Board and discussion with the CPAN community in the plenary session.
- **20 December 2024:** First draft of the Spanish CPAN input document ready and distributed to the Spanish community (via cpan-investigadores@pegaso.ific.uv.es and gen-fpa@pegaso.ific.uv.es)
- **February 2025** (exact date to be confirmed): Final discussion on the document to converge on possible changes.
- **31 March 2025:** Send Spanish CPAN input document.
