



Now devoted to **experimental** and **theoretical** research in Nuclear, Particle and Astroparticle Physics, and applications such as Medical Physics (personnel ~380)


- Origin of mass: understanding the fundamental laws of physics

- Raise awareness about the issue of stereotypes and unconscious bias














Contributing to CSIC/UV equality plans (work/life balance: teleworking, childcare, etc.)







The workshop will feature Physics Talks given by researchers who are actively involved in inclusivity events and activities, or/and who are openly part of the LGBTQIA+ community
