- 11 requests for titles reissue



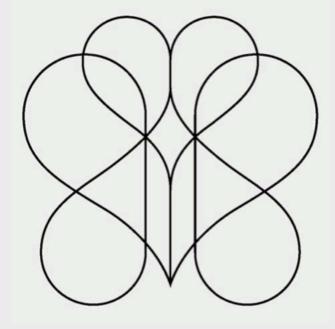

Changing the inertias and dynamics of work in a University that is more than 520 years old is no easy task. Following the approval in 2019 of the 'Protocol for attention to gender identity and expression at the University', and in order to pave the way for the development of the 1st Diversity Plan, the MIDICO research team (Migrations, Diversity and Coexistence) was commissioned to carry out a diagnostic study on LGTBI and ethnocultural diversity among the University's student body, addressing the realities of LGTBI students, the Roma community, Afro-descendants and students wearing hijab. With this research we begin a path towards social justice that makes the University of Valencia an example to the citizens, public administrations and the business and associative fabric, with the aim that our students will go through a more democratic and respectful University and that, in their professional future, they will be able to take this spirit wherever they go.

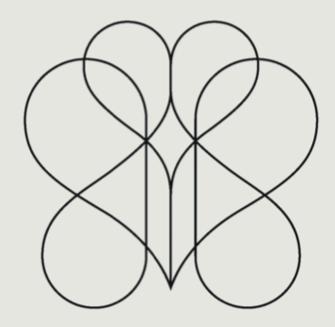

This research, promoted by the 'Diversitats' initiative of the Vice-Rectorate for Equality, Diversity and Sustainability of the University of Valencia, represents a second phase and completes the study 'Diagnosi sobre diversitats LGTB i etnoculturals entre l'estudiantat de la Universitat de València' (Diagnosis on LGTB and ethnocultural diversities among students at the University of Valencia), published in 2021. This publication deals with the analysis of first cycle students from Eastern Europe and Latin America, as well as second and third cycle foreign students, in addition to teaching and research staff and administration and services staff of non-Spanish nationality. In this way, an updated and general diagnosis is available on realities and perceptions in terms of ethno-cultural diversity and LGTB plurality at the University of Valencia, taking into account the different groups that make up the university community, which, in turn, is a reflection of Valencian society and its social transformations. This second volume is the result of the commitment of the Universitat de València to provide useful knowledge that allows an emancipating view of society that accompanies and guides the university community, as well as the different bodies of this institution, towards a structural change and democratic deepening in the organisational and academic framework of the university. The proposed debates and reflections will deepen the complexity implied by diversity and, at the same time, contribute to the necessary cultural and institutional transformation towards more egalitarian, inclusive, plural, fair and sustainable societies.

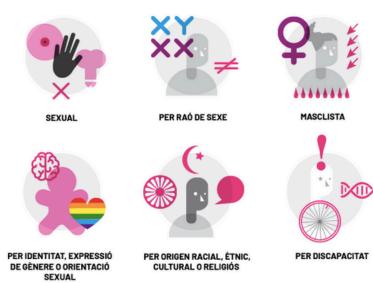

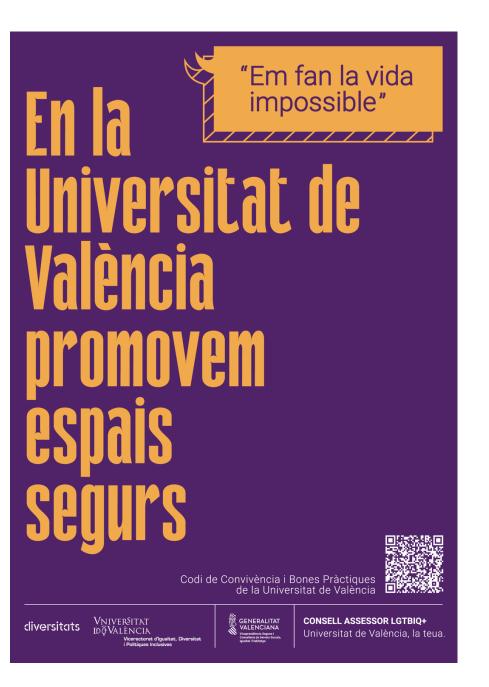

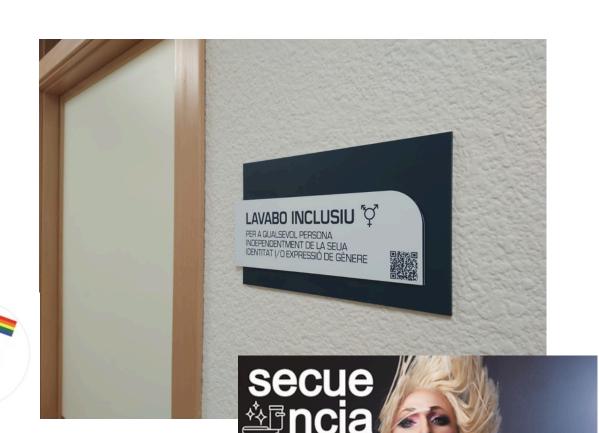




Burjassot-Paterna Campus Map.
